Mauro Ceruti

Heis one of the pioneers and developers of Complex Systems Theories, Methods and Epistemologies, and of the trans-disciplinary research line usually called "Complex Thinking", which aims at the innovation of the paradigms of (scientific) rationality. Ceruti's philosophical reflections and productions are at the intersection between a plurality of research domains, among which they stimulate inter- and trans-disciplinary debate on complexity: Epistemology, Natural Sciences, Human Sciences, Sciences of Organization and Management, among others. His writings have been published in Italian, English, French, German, Portuguese, Romanian, Spanish, and Turkish. Ceruti studied Philosophy at the University of Milan (Italy) with Ludovico Geymonat. From 1981 to 1986 Ceruti worked at the University of Geneva, Faculty of Psychology and Educational Sciences, and at the Genetic Epistemology International Centre founded by Jean Piaget, developing and expanding his Evolutionary Epistemology project to create a new trans-disciplinary research program, dedicated to structure an Anthropology and Epistemology of Complex Systems, as well as a Complex Anthropology and Epistemology. Since 1994 Ceruti has been Professor in the domain of Epistemology and Philosophy of Science in different Italian universities.
